About the fellowship: Makerere University, in collaboration with the Universitat Rovira i Virgili (Tarragona, Spain), under the Erasmus+ project 2023-1-ES01-KA171-HED-000144411 is announcing an International Erasmus+ scholarship call for Faculty /Project Members engaged at Makerere University. The successful staff shall be hosted as an international exchange staff at the Universitat Rovira i Virgili (Tarragona, Spain) for a stay within the framework of the Erasmus+ Program, from November 24 to 28, 2025.

What is covered: The scholarship covers travel expenses, accommodation, and your subsistence while in Spain.

Eligibility: Applicant should have an MSc and a Bachelors in Veterinary Medicine or Bachelor's in Animal Production with a graduate training in the fields of: Animal production, veterinary medicine, Infectious disease management, and must have participated in some of the activities of Innovation for Sustainability and Societal relevance: Partnerships in evidence-based higher Education on food systems and climate change (INSSPIRE project).

How to apply: Qualified and interested staff can apply to the Head of Department. The deadline for the application is **10th September 2025 at 5:00 pm**. Applications should be delivered by hand to the Department Office RM 422 COVAB Level 4.

Applications should include an application letter, a Curriculum Vitae, and Academic documents. The application letter should have a statement of purpose and career goals.

Applicants should name two academic referees and their contacts. Letters of reference are not required at this point.
